Start a walking bus or bike bus at your school

A walking bus is a group of kids and adults who walk to school together on a regular route and schedule; a bike bus does the same on bicycles. Both turn the trip to school into active time with friends and neighbors. *Walking buses are usually the simplest option.*

WHY START ONE?

- Kids start the day active and ready to learn
- Families spend less time in the drop-off line
- Neighbors build stronger connections

THREE WAYS TO BEGIN

- 1 Choose one or more days each week to walk or bike.

- 3 Invite other families to join you.
